
Standard-type apartments, November 1, 2011

In October of 2011, minimum price changes were observed in the standard-type apartment market. The average price of standard-type apartments in October 2011 has declined to **583 EUR/m²**. Thus, the price level in October decreased only by 0.2%, which does not indicate the presence of any considerable trends in the market. Since the beginning of 2011, the average prices of standard-type apartments have decreased by **4.3%** in total.


In 2011, the overall activity in the real estate market has not survived any significant jumps or drops. Prices have become stagnant and, in general during 2011, the prices have declined slightly. In some neighborhoods the price reduction has exceeded 7%, which is nevertheless considered to be a significant fall in prices. Thus, any signs of market recovery or growth at least in the apartment market have not been observed this year.

The number of apartments offered in the market has decreased slightly in October. In Riga the total the number of apartments offered in the market has increased by 1.1 %, but in the largest housing estates this number has decreased by 2.9%. The number of offered apartments that are located in the central part of Riga has increased by 7.6.

In most neighborhoods no price changes were observed. The largest price change in October was observed at Mežciems – the prices declined by 0.8% on average.

Since the beginning of 2011, the average price of 1 m² of a standard-type apartment has decreased by 4.3%. The biggest price drop as per November 1, 2011 was observed at Kengarags – by -7.5%. But the smallest price drop has been observed at Teika where the prices during this year have declined only by 1%.

Price changes since January 1, 2011





In October 2011 the apartment prices in housing estates were at the level of April 2010. Since September 2009 when the price level was the lowest, the prices have grown by 19.9%.

In October 2011 the average standard-apartment price has decreased to <u>583 EUR/m²</u>. The prices on average were <u>by 64% lower than on July 1, 2007</u>, when the average price of a non-renovated standard-type apartment had reached the highest ever value of 1620 EUR/m². But the average price of a non-renovated standard-type apartment has decreased by 4.3% if compared with the price level of January 1, 2011.

In 2008, the average prices of standard-type apartments in Riga decreased by 33.5% on average. In 2009, the average prices decreased by another 44,2%. But in 2010 the prices grew by 16.9% in total.

In the housing estates analyzed by the ARCO REAL ESTATE in October 2011, the average price of a 1-room apartment was 622 EUR/m², and compared with the price of the previous month, this price has remained unchanged; average price of a 2-room standard-type apartment was 589 EUR/m², and compared with the average price of the previous month, this price has decreased by 0.3%; average price of a 3-room apartment was 563 EUR/m², and compared with the prices of the previous month, this price has decreased by 0.2%; average price of a 4-room apartment was 558 EUR/m², and compared with the average price of the previous month, this price has decreased by 0.4%.

Average prices of standard-type apartments in Riga housing estates: breakdown by number of rooms (EUR/m²)




Number of apartments offered for sale in October 2011, compared with the level of the previous month, has slightly decreased in the largest housing estates analyzed by the ARCO REAL ESTATE (-2.9%); however, in the Riga City in total it has slightly increased (1.1%). The number of apartments offered and located in the central part of Riga has increased by 7.6%.

Having analyzed the number of apartments offered we can see that the biggest number of apartments offered in October were located at Purvciems, Plavnieki, Imanta and Kengarags. In contrast, the smallest number of apartments offered was at Bolderāja and Zolitūde. In October, the number of apartments offered decreased in most housing estates. In October, the largest decrease of number of apartments offered was observed at Vecmīlgrāvis – by 17.3%. The largest increase of supply of apartments was observed at Bolderāja and Purvciems – by 3.8%. The most popular apartments in the housing estates of Riga were 1-room and 2-room apartments. But 4-room apartments were the less popular ones.

In October 2011, the average price of 1 $\rm m^2$ has decreased in most housing estates. Average price of 1 $\rm m^2$ has decreased by 0.2-0.8%. The biggest price drop in October was observed at Mežciems, where the prices decreased by 0.8% on average. But at Jugla and Imanta positive price fluctuations were observed – by +0.4% and +0.2%, respectively. Solely at Purvciems the prices remained unchanged in October.



Since the beginning of 2011, the standard-type apartment prices have decreased by 4.3%. From the beginning of 2010, the prices have grown by 11.9% on average. Compared with the beginning of 2009, in October 2011 the standard-type apartment prices in the housing estates of Riga were by 37.6% higher. Since the lowest price point in September 2009 when the average price of 1 m² in the Riga's housing estates had decreased to 487 EUR, the prices have grown by 19.7% on average.


Average standard-type apartment prices in Riga housing estates (EUR/m²)

The highest prices in October 2011 were still observed at *Teika*, where the average price of 1m² has decreased slightly and was amounting to 717 EUR. In turn, the lowest prices in October 2011 were observed at *Bolderāja*, where the average price of 1m² has remained unchanged - 479 EUR.

Average standard-type apartment prices in Riga housing estates in October 2011



In October 2011, the <u>most expensive</u> apartments still were apartments in the houses of the 119th series and 104th series, where the price of 2-room apartments varied from 32 to 39 thousand EUR, depending on location. But the so-called *Lithuanian design houses* have been the <u>cheapest</u> ones, where the price of 2-room apartments varied from 21 to 28 thousand EUR, and the so-called *Khrushchev-time houses*, where the price of 2-room apartments varied from 19 to 28 thousand EUR, depending on the housing estate.

Jūrmala, Kauguri

In October 2011 the apartment prices at Kauguri <u>decreased by 0.5% on average</u>. The average price in Octrober was <u>427 EUR/m²</u>. During 2011 the prices at Kauguri have decreased by 7.8%. The most expensive apartments at Kauguri still were the *103rd series* apartments, but the cheapest apartments were in the *Khrushchev-time houses* and *small-family* houses.

Jelgava

In October 2011 the apartment prices in Jelgava remained unchanged. The market activity in Jelgava is still low. In 2011 the apartment prices in Jelgava tended to decline, and since the beginning of 2011 the prices have decreased by 13.2% on average. The average price in September still was 303 EUR/m². Apartments located in the central part of the city with high-standard interior decoration are most demanded and most popular.

Salaspils

In October 2011, the apartment prices in Salaspils <u>decreased by 1.9% on average</u>. The average price in October was as low as <u>481 EUR/m²</u>. In 2010 in total, the apartment prices at Salaspils increased by <u>22</u>%. In 2011 the apartment prices in Salaspils have tended to decline, and since the beginning of the year the prices have decreased by 7.8% on average.

Ogre

The average prices in Ogre in October 2011 <u>remained unchanged</u> if compared with the average prices of September 2011. The average apartment price in October still was <u>426 EUR/m²</u>.

Since the beginning of 2011 the prices have decreased by 2.8% on average in Ogre. The activity in the apartment market of Ogre is to be considered low.
